E-Mods

Get your home environmentally modified for your loved one's needs

Stay where you are—no matter what.

No one should ever have to leave home because of a physical impairment. E-mods are constructive alterations to a home or vehicle that help an OPWDD-eligible individual with physical disabilities get around with more safety and independence.



OPWDD-eligible E-mods include these and more:

- Ramps
- Lifts (Hydraulic, manual or electric)
- Widened doorways and hallways
- Handrails and grab bars
- Automatic or manual door openers and doorbells
- Bathroom and kitchen modifications
- Cabinet and shelving adaptations



Self-Direction

Get reimbursed for clothing, goods, emergency respite and summer camp

You're in charge. We're here for support.

If you'd like to manage your own OPWDD budget toward achieving goals, Self-Direction helps you make that choice. Learn if Self-Direction makes sense for you, and get assistance in choosing where to allocate funds—whether toward community classes, memberships, self-hired care providers, home-related subsidies and services, and more.



Your Hamaspik-appointed Fiscal Intermediary will work closely with you, providing administrative and billing support throughout your person-centered service program.

P.S. If you find that Self-Direction is not right for you, you can always switch back to the traditional services model.

Special needs need not break the bank.

Hamaspik's goal is to provide differently-abled individuals with the best possible advantages in life—and a normal, financially secure childhood is a good place to start. Our state-funded family reimbursement program is there to cover the many additional costs that come along with having a special needs child.



FSS reimbursements include:

- **Goods and services** needed by the individual, like clothing and adaptive devices
- **Emergency respite** for crisis situations not covered by standard OPWDD respite
- **Summer camp** to give your child a wholesome summer—and you a needed break
